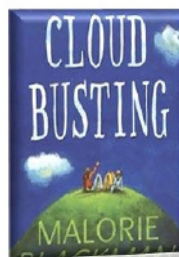
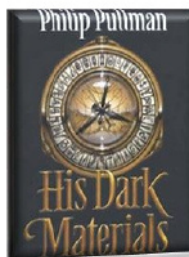
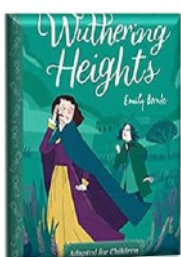


September's Musician of the Month
