Dear Parents/Carers

A week can be a very long time! Monday morning seems like a distant memory. Well done to all those who have supported their children with home learning. The expectations this time are much higher than in the previous lockdown.

The remote education provided should be equivalent in length to the core teaching pupils would receive in school and will include both recorded direct teaching time, and time for pupils to complete tasks and assignments independently.

The amount of remote education provided should be, as a minimum:

• Key Stage 1: 3 hours a day on average across the cohort, with less for younger children

• Key Stage 2: 4 hours a day

Schools are expected to check daily, whether pupils are engaging with their work, and work with families to rapidly identify effective solutions where engagement is a concern. If you have any problems with engaging with home learning please contact us by eSchools, telephone or email.

I hope you are able to take time to relax at the weekend and will be ready to go again on Monday.
