Events for Book Week:


Monday 4^{th} March - Booknic - parents and carers are welcome to come and share books with the children in a relaxed way throughout the school. Come along at 2.30 and read together.






Reem Kelani

Pupils in England will have the choice to take a GCSE exam in British Sign Language (BSL) from 2025. BSL is a form of communication using hand gestures and other movements. Pupils, who take the subject, will learn around 1,000 different signs.
