Following a hugely successful trip again last year, we will be visiting the Delaware Outdoor Education Centre in the Summer Term from Monday 24<sup>th</sup> – Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> June 2019.

Delaware Outdoor Education Centre specialises in a wide range of activities and is superbly located on the outskirts of Gunnislake in the picturesque Tamar Valley Peninsula. The centre is owned and operated by Cornwall Local Authority. It is a converted school containing five main dormitories and two leader's rooms, with a modern kitchen and large day / dining room. There are the usual washing, shower, drying and toilet facilities.

The Delaware Centre focuses on outdoor pursuits and their experienced instructors have an excellent reputation for delivering safe and enjoyable activities. Activities will be selected dependent upon numbers and weather conditions, from archery, raft building, canoeing, rock climbing, mountain biking, moorland exploration, gorge walking, orienteering and problem solving. All of these activities have an indoor option if the weather is bad.

The cost of the trip this year is £160.00. This may be paid in instalments or in one go via Parent Pay. We require a deposit of £50.00 to secure a place on the trip by 8th February 2019 and the full amount needs to be paid by the 31st May 2019. (Deposits are non-refundable, as we have to pay for the number of places that we book). Please login to your ParentPay Account to pay your deposit and secure a place on this residential.

We will be holding a meeting to discuss the residential at 3:20pm on **Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> January** in Sennen Class. The aim of this meeting will be to give more information about the details of the trip and answer any questions you may have so please attend before making a decision!
