Plans have now been agreed for the year 6 residential trip and we are very excited to inform you that we have decided to take the children back to London this year. The last four years have been incredible popular and successful we have already booked for next year and plan to follow a similar schedule to this year. Plans are still being finalised but below is our proposed itinerary for the trip based on last year:

In London, we will be staying aboard the Lord Amory. The ship is based in the West India Dock Complex to the east side of London and is owned by the Docklands Scout Project. The ship will remain moored in the docklands and the children will stay in cabins of varying size. The ship will be exclusively used by our school for the duration of our stay.

We understand that you will have many questions and therefore a meeting will be arranged for September to discuss the trip and answer any queries. During this meeting we will discuss the arrangements for the week including travel, accommodation and the proposed itinerary. We would like to make this trip available to all children and would therefore appreciate it if all parents could attend the meeting. There is, of course, a cost for attending the residential and we understand that some families will find this difficult and would like to remind you to talk to the school if you have concerns about this so we can offer as much support as we are able to. Our aim is to take as many of the children as possible and would like for you to discuss your concerns with us before automatically ruling out your child being able to attend.

The cost for the trip will be £350. To reserve a space, you need to return the slip below and a <u>non-refundable deposit</u> of £100 should be made by Parent pay by Friday 28th September. In order to make it easier and spread the payments over the year, a second instalment of £50 will be due by 31 January 2019, another £100 by 22 March 2019 and the final £100 will need to be paid by 22 May 2019. We do not expect you to make any payments before you have been to the meeting however, a number of parents wanted the option of making payments towards the trip over the summer. We hope you are all as excited as we are about this fantastic residential for year 6 and are looking forward to seeing as many of you as possible after school in September.
