# Policy for Emergency School Closure

As we hit the winter period, with its possibility for school closure due to severe weather (e.g. snow or flood), building problems (e.g. loss of heating, loss of power), I thought it would be useful to remind you of the procedure for closing the school. I am not expecting this to happen and very much hope that we do not need to do it. Please keep this in a safe place. A copy is also on the school website at www.carclazesch.org

In the unlikely event of storm damage or bad weather (snow) forcing the school to close, the following procedure will be taken:

**1 - Closure before school begins (i.e. overnight or before 8am):** Information will be broadcast on Radio Cornwall, Pirate FM and Heart FM. Our website will be updated as soon as possible. We will also send a text to all parents who have registered their number with us. Please do not drop children into school or allow them to walk to school before checking the website.

**2 - Closure during the Academy day:** Messages will go out on local radio and on the school website. We will also use the text system for those parents/carers who are registered with us. Please collect your child as soon as possible once notified. Children will be sent out through their classrooms once an adult arrives on site to collect them.

Please be aware that we will inform you through local radio, texts and email that the school is closing during the day, but with over four hundred parents to contact the phone lines will be busy and we will do our up most to communicate with you as best we can.

Thank you for your support with this. The safety and well-being of our students will be the first priority in all decisions on school closure.

#### **RE: ATTENDANCE PROCEDURES AND EXPECTATIONS**

Dear Parent/Carer

Here at Carclaze Community Primary School, we recognise that there are occasions when it is appropriate to authorise an absence, such as when a pupil is genuinely too ill to attend school, has a medical appointment that cannot be taken outside of school hours or a request for leave has been agreed in exceptional circumstances.

However, the Government does not support parents taking children out of school unless the school agrees this is appropriate under 'exceptional circumstances'. Any request for leave should be made in writing to the Head Teacher using the school's request form at least 14 days prior to the proposed date of absence.

If you decide to still take your child out of school, without permission, you will be committing an offence under the Education Act 1996. We may refer the matter to Cornwall Council who may decide to take legal action against you. A penalty notice can be issued under Section 444A and 444B of the Education Act 1996. This carries a fine of £60 if paid within 21 days or £120 if paid after this but within 28 days. **Penalty Notice fines are issued per parent/carer, per child**. Failure to pay the penalty notice may result in Court action. Persistent absences not authorised by the school may result in a prosecution in the Magistrates Court, leading to fines up to £2,500 and/or custodial sentences \*. The Council may also apply for the costs incurred in taking the matter to Court.

You are welcome to contact the school to discuss any concerns you may have regarding this or if you feel you would like advice or support in helping your child attend more regularly. Carclaze Community Primary School is committed to maximising the education of all its pupils and aims to work with parents to ensure this can be achieved.

\* For an offence under the Education Act 1996 Sec 444 (1) the maximum fine is £1000. For an offence under the Education Act 1996 Sec 444 (1A) the maximum fine is £2500 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 3 months. Alternatively, a penalty notice may be issued under Section 444A and 444B of the Education Act 1996. This carries a fine of £60 if paid within 21 days or £120 if paid after this but within 28 days. Failure to pay the penalty notice may result in Court action.

#### **GENERAL ATTENDANCE INFORMATION FOR PARENTS**

Dear Parents/Carers

The School opens to pupils at 8.40am. Our registers are taken at 8.50am. Pupils arriving after 8.50am but between these two times are marked as Present (code /).

Our morning registers close at 9.10am. Pupils arriving between 8.50am and the close time will be marked as late (code L).

Pupils arriving after this time will be marked as an <u>unauthorised lateness</u> (code U).

Unauthorised absence can mean that legal action could be taken against you – in these circumstances we will work with you to avoid the need for this course of action to be taken.

#### **Dental/Medical Appointments**

As a school we ask that wherever possible general dental and medical appointments are made outside school hours. Where they have to be made within school hours we would expect your child to come into school prior to the appointment and return to school as soon as possible after the appointment.

There is <u>no</u> expectation that orthodontic or hospital appointments are taken outside school hours. We appreciate that these appointments are difficult to get outside school times. In these cases, please provide us with a copy of the hospital/dental appointment letter as early as possible.

#### **Holidays During Term Time**

Unless there are exceptional circumstances it is unlikely that leave during term time will be granted. If you are likely to take leave during the term please complete the **exceptional leave request form** and return to the school office <u>at</u> <u>least 2 weeks prior to your possible leave date</u>.

#### **Unauthorised Absences**

Absences which are not authorised are monitored by our school Education Welfare Officer. It is likely that if there are a number of unauthorised absences on your child's absence record that you will be invited to attend an appointment with myself, Alisa Shopland (Attendance Officer) and our Education Welfare Officer. These meetings are designed to be supportive and we would encourage you to attend wherever possible.
