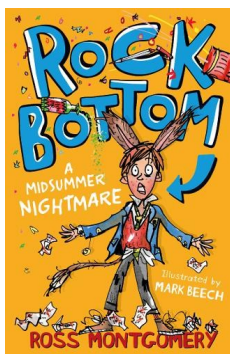

Attendance

After half term you will be receiving a communication with updated information about attendance expectations and when penalty notices may be issued. There is a requirement for this to go to both parents. You will receive it even if your child has 100% attendance. It is for information but please read it and let us know if you have any questions.

If your child has less than 90% attendance you will have already received a letter to let you know what their attendance is, this is because attendance less than 90% is classified as persistent absence and we need to work with you to increase this.

What's going on this week?



This year's Nobel Prize winners have been announced and include two American scientists, who discovered how we feel physical pain and pleasure, winning the 2021 Nobel Prize for medicine. The annual awards take place in Sweden and there are six subject areas: Physics, Chemistry, Medicine, Literature, Peace and Economics. Each Nobel award comes with a gold medal and a prize of 10 million Swedish krona (about £840,000).

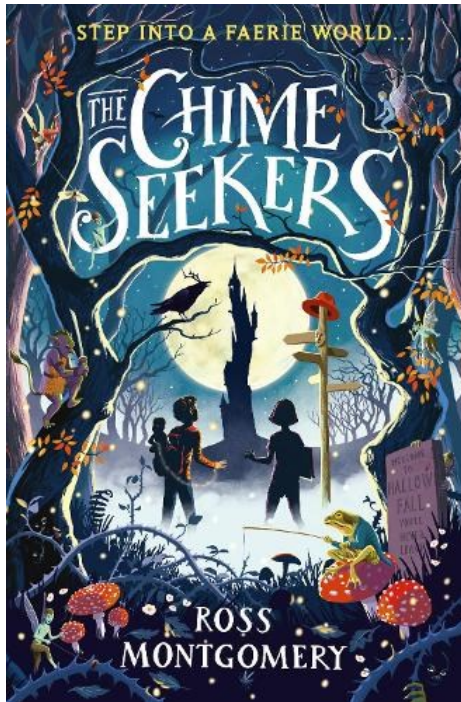
