### **LUNCHES**

All school lunches MUST be booked on PARENTPAY by midnight on the Sunday before the new school week. Parents of children in EYFS, Year 1 and Year 2 do not have to pay for lunches as they are provided free of charge by the government <u>but these lunches still need to be booked</u>. Failure to book will result in us asking you to send in a packed lunch for the remainder of the week.

Not only will this allow your child to receive free school meals, but this will also bring additional funding into the school, which can be used to support your child's learning, extra-curricular activities, trips and uniform.

### **SNACKS**

Fruit is provided free of charge for children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2.

We are a Healthy School, therefore all Key Stage 2 children <u>must</u> bring a healthy snack for break times no crisps or chocolate please.

#### **UNIFORM**

#### **FOOTWEAR**

School shoes need to be black. Trainers are not to be worn, except for during PE.

#### **PE KIT**

We will be continuing with our COVID routine where children will come to school wearing their PE kit on PE days. We have had feedback that parents and children prefer this as it means fewer lost PE kits, and, for us, it has meant more teaching time for PE.

PE Kit should be black shorts (or jogging bottoms) and white T-Shirt. We will also look to make available some purple polo shirts and hoodies for the winter (more info to follow). Children should not wear football shirts or any other non-uniform kit.
