**Nuts - Please can we remind parents once again that we are a 'nut free school' due to the severe allergies of some of our children.**

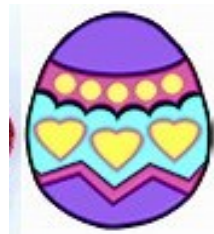

#### **Swimming Lessons:**

Spring Term 2019 - Year 3 and 4 will Swim for 10 weeks from Tuesday 15th January to Tuesday 26th March 2019. 1.30-2.30

#### **Summer Term 2019 - Swimming Lessons**

##### **Year 1/2 Swimming**

We are constantly reviewing our practice and have decided that we will not run swimming sessions for Year 1 and 2.

The main reasons for this are:

- It is not a requirement for children to have swimming lessons in school until Key Stage 2
- The time children need to get changed means the amount of time they have in the pool is greatly reduced.
- The support needed to help with changing is greater than the number of staff who can attend.

The cost of providing the lessons is far greater than contributions received for these sessions.

We believe it is important that children learn to swim. The ideal way is for children to attend the pool from an early age either with parents or for swimming lessons either one to one or in a small group. School sessions can then help to develop skills in larger groups.
