Dear Parents/Carers

With the current rise in covid cases in our area (at least 3 St Austell schools have bubbles isolating) and the delay in the easing of covid restrictions please try and continue to take precautions including social distancing and wearing masks.

Some of the positive cases in the area thought they had a cold or hay fever so continued to go to school. The electric scooters, also known as e-scooters, are now available to rent in selected areas of London as part of a one-year scheme to measure their feasibility. As part of the trial, conducted by TFL (Transport for London) and London councils, the scooters are banned on pavements and limited to 15.5mph. Privately owned e-scooters remain illegal on most roads and cycle lanes due to a law dating back to the 1800s.
