We have so far had around 20 children who have signed up for the Year 4 residential trip to Delaware but we would like to take a lot more!

The trip really is an amazing experience for both the children and adults and an opportunity to have a go at activities we are unable to offer in school. It allows children to show off skills and talents we may not be able to see on a daily basis in the classroom and is also a brilliant way of bringing the children together as a team.

A reminder of the details:

- We will be visiting the Delaware Outdoor Education Centre in the Summer Term from **Monday 24th – Wednesday 26th June 2019**.
- The Delaware Centre focuses on outdoor pursuits and their experienced instructors have an excellent reputation for delivering safe and enjoyable activities. Activities will be selected dependent upon numbers and weather conditions, from archery, raft building, canoeing, rock climbing, mountain biking, moorland exploration, gorge walking, orienteering and problem solving. All of these activities have an indoor option if the weather is bad.
- The cost of the trip this year is **£160.00**. This may be paid in instalments or in one go via Parent Pay.
- We require a deposit of **£50.00** to secure a place on the trip. In order to get as many children as possible to attend, we will be extending the deadline to pay the deposit until **Friday 15th February**.
- The remaining balance needs to be paid by 31st May 2019. Please speak to your child's class teacher or the school office if you would like information on support that the school may be able to offer with payment.
