Online Safety - we received information this week regarding a disturbing new game sweeping social media. We are urging parents to visit the Daily Mail Website and read up on the 'Momo Challenge'.

Extract from the Daily Mail:

‘A disturbing new game sweeping social media has parents and authorities concerned that we may be seeing the rise of another ‘Blue Whale’ phenomenon. It’s been popping up all over the world in recent weeks, predominantly through WhatsApp, and appears to follow roughly the same script every time. First, users are challenged to contact ‘Momo’ by sending messages to an unknown number – then, they’re hounded with frightening images and violent messages.


Apps – Websites – Useful Information

School Uniforms



Please can we remind parents of the school rules surrounding School Uniforms?

It is important that all children come to school dressed and wearing the correct uniform.

- **Grey/Black – Trousers, Shorts, Skirt or Dress (Purple Check Summer Dresses)**
- **White Polo Shirt, Shirt or Blouse**
- **White, Grey or Black Tights or Socks**
- **Purple School Cardigan, Jumper or Fleece**
- **PE KIT – Black Shorts – White T-shirt's – Sensible Trainers or Plimsolls (Black Hoodies and Leggings for winter sports if required)**
- **Black School Shoes - not trainers or knee high boots.**

NO – Purple Tights or Purple Polo Shirts to be worn. NO Trainers during the day – only for sports

NO - Jewellery (only stud earrings) makeup or nail varnish.

NO – Purple Polo Shirts or Bright Socks to be worn. NO Trainers during the day – only for sports.

Morning Drop off Procedures:

Please note that all children in years FS-4 should be accompanied to their classrooms in the mornings by an adult and not left at the gate to walk down by themselves. They are too young for this responsibility and if anything happened to them we would be unable to help as they are unsupervised outside at this time.

Please can we remind parents and carers of the following when using the car park. These rules are in place to keep you and the children safe during school pick up and drop offs:

CAR PARK

- ◆ Please reverse park into a space - this means that once you have your child you can drive out safely.
- ◆ **DO NOT PARK** in Taxi Bays - We have several children travelling alone by taxi and for their safety the bays must be kept clear. Anyone parking in a Taxi Bay will be asked to move.
- ◆ Disabled Bays are for disabled drivers only (Blue badge holders only)
- ◆ Staff Car Park - **DO NOT** cross the zebra crossing and use the Staff Car Park.

GENERAL SAFETY

- ◆ Can we remind parents that school opens at 8.40am. Prior to this children are not supervised so please do not drop them off and leave. If you have to drop off before 8.25 then children need to be booked into Breakfast Club.
- ◆ When dropping children off please use the pedestrian 'walk ways and paths'. Do not walk through the Staff Car Park as this is dangerous for both you and your children.
