<u>Important Information Regarding</u> Medication

Please be aware that from September 2018 we will no longer be giving 'non prescription' medication to children during the school day.

If your child is unwell and you would like them to take a non-prescription medication throughout the day then you are welcome to come into school to administer it. Ideally, we would recommend that children be given medication prior to the school day where possible.

For prescribed medications, inhalers and creams - please ensure you complete the medical consent forms to authorise us to administer the prescribed dosage throughout the school day.



CHANGE TO SCHOOL DINNER MENU

Please note that on our return from half term on the 31st October, the cook is swapping Wednesday and Thursday's lunches around for the **first week back only**.



Therefore school lunch on the Wednesday will be Chicken Curry with Rice and not Roast Pork.

The roast will be on the Thursday (1st Nov) as the Cook cannot do a roast on the first day back due to deliveries of produce etc.

Please can we remind parents and carers of the following when using the car park.

These rules are in place to keep you and the children safe during school pick up and drop offs:

CAR PARK

- Please reversepark into a space this means that once you have your child you can drive out safely.
- DO NOT PARK in Taxi Bays We have several children travelling alone by taxi and for their safety the bays must be kept clear. Anyone parking in a Taxi Bay will be asked to move.
- Disabled Bays (unless you have a blue badge) are for disabled drivers only.
- Staff Car Park DO NOT cross the zebra crossing and use the Staff Car Park.

GENERAL SAFETY

- opens at 8.40am. Prior to this children are not supervised so please do not drop them off and leave. If you have to drop off before 8.25 then children need to be booked into Breakfast Club.
- When dropping children off please use the pedestrian 'walk ways and paths'. Do not walk through the Staff Car Park as this is dangerous for both you and your children.

The above rules are to keep you and your children safe whilst on school grounds - thank you for your co-operation.

AVOIDABLE ABSENCE IN TERM TIME

IMPORTANT: Please read carefully the information below.

WARNING: If you allow your child to miss school in term time for an avoidable reason without obtaining the prior approval of the school, you may be issued with a Penalty Notice* per parent per child, or made the subject of court proceedings under section 444 Education Act 1996.

As a parent/carer, you can demonstrate your commitment to your child's education by not allowing your child to miss school for anything other than an exceptional and unavoidable reason.

THE FACTS

School aged pupils in Cornwall maintained schools are expected to attend punctually on the 190 days that the school is open. Whilst there are a number of unavoidable reasons why a pupil might be away from school (illness, medical appointments, exclusions etc.) the legislation is clear that any avoidable absence may only be authorised by a school if there are exceptional circumstances.

WHAT YOU SHOULD CONSIDER

Research suggests that children who are taken out of school may never catch up on the learning they have missed. This may affect test results and can be particularly harmful if the child is studying for final year examinations.

Children who struggle with English or Mathematics may also find it even harder to cope when they return to school, while younger children may find it difficult to renew friendships with their classmates.

If the school is unable to authorise the absence and the child is still taken out of school, this will be recorded as **unauthorised absence** and you may receive a £60* fine per parent per child.

Unavoidable absence from school will be authorised. Examples include:

Genuine illness

Unavoidable medical/dental appointments (but try to make these after school if at all possible).

Days of religious observance.

Seeing a parent who is on leave from the armed forces External examinations

When traveller children are on the road with their parents

THE LAW

The law allows the school to consider individual requests to authorise a future avoidable absence. However, before the school can authorise any such requests, they must satisfy themselves that there are exceptional circumstances which justify such a decision. It is entirely the responsibility of the parent submitting the request to provide sufficient evidence/information in order to establish this fact. The request for leave must come from the parent with whom the child normally resides.

If a child then stays away from school for more than the authorised period this must be recorded as unauthorised absence and could be quoted in a prosecution for poor attendance.

If the child is away for a period of four weeks or more, the school may have the option to take the child off roll subject to the Education (Pupil Registration) (England) Regulations 2006.

In case of unexpected extended absence, it is advisable that the parent fully informs the school as to the reasons. If a child is removed from roll, there is no guarantee that the child will regain a place at the school.

Other examples of absence from school that will not be authorised include:

Any type of shopping

Looking after siblings or unwell parents

Minding the house

Birthdays

Resting after a late night

Relatives visiting or visiting relatives

The law requires parents to ensure their children receive an efficient full time education, and every minute of every day is important. Please help them not to miss any of this valuable time.

We hope that when you have read this leaflet you will consider that your child's education is too important to allow them to miss school for avoidable reasons.

Dear Parent/Carer

Penalty Notice Reminder

Here at Carclaze Community Primary School, we recognise that there are occasions when it is appropriate to authorise an absence, such as when a pupil is genuinely too ill to attend school, has a medical appointment that cannot be taken outside of school hours or a request for leave has been agreed in exceptional circumstances.

However, the Government does not support parents taking children out of school unless the school agrees this is appropriate under 'exceptional circumstances'. Any request for leave should be made in writing to the Head Teacher using the school's request form.

If you decide to still take your child out of school, without permission, you will be committing an offence under the Education Act 1996. We may refer the matter to Cornwall Council who may decide to take legal action against you. A penalty notice can be issued under Section 444A and 444B of the Education Act 1996. This carries a fine of £60 if paid within 21 days or £120 if paid after this but within 28 days. Failure to pay the penalty notice may result in Court action. Persistent absences not authorised by the school may result in a prosecution in the Magistrates Court, leading to fines up to £2,500 and/or custodial sentences *. The Council may also apply for the costs incurred in taking the matter to Court.

You are welcome to contact the school to discuss any concerns you may have regarding this or if you feel you would like advice or support in helping your child attend more regularly. Carclaze Community Primary School is committed to maximising the education of all its pupils and aims to work with parents to ensure this can be achieved.

* For an offence under the Education Act 1996 Sec 444 (1) the maximum fine is £1000. For an offence under the Education Act 1996 Sec 444 (1A) the maximum fine is £2500 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 3 months. Alternatively, a penalty notice may be issued under Section 444A and 444B of the Education Act 1996. This carries a fine of £60 if paid within 21 days or £120 if paid after this but within 28 days. Failure to pay the penalty notice may result in Court action.
