

A Parent / Carer Guide to Distance Learning at Carclaze Primary School

How will teachers set work and how can we help?

Teachers will set work on eSchools using the below timetable (PE will set an active task each day)

All work should be completed by the deadline given by the teacher-likely to be a week later.

Teachers will acknowledge completion and then feedback if appropriate.

Encourage your child to work for about 1 – 1.5 hours a day. Help them structure their day, have a place to work, and work without social media distractions.

Are they stuck? Use any books they have at home, own research, or call on friends to help.

Praise and celebrate their work, their resilience and their knowledge!

How will teachers feedback work?



Your child needs to upload the work as the teacher has asked.



Not all work will need to be uploaded and, just like in the classroom, not all work will be marked.

Marked work could be given back as whole class feedback where the teacher reflects on next steps suitable to all; or individually using eSchools
