In real terms, the reduction in funding to schools over the past 10 years means it is increasingly hard to provide the same resources, to recruit and retain staff and to make sure every child gets a good education every day.

Everyone at Carclaze goes above and beyond their role for our children and will continue to do so. Unfortunately, whilst the funding and pay dispute continues it looks like industrial action will continue and possibly escalate as more unions are balloting their members about strike action.

We realise that strike days will be an inconvenience but hope you understand the reasons for the disruption.

I don't want my message to you to be full of doom and gloom so I will end with two examples of how Carclaze are continuing to ensure our children get the best possible experiences.


