DATA COLLECTION SHEETS

Over the next few days we will be sending home a data collection sheet for each child. Please check that all the information on this sheet is correct and sign/date the form and return it to your child's class teacher. If it is not correct please make any changes on the form and again sign/date it and return to your child's class teacher as soon as possible.

Hand Sanitiser

We have plenty of hand sanitiser in school so we request that children do not bring their own.

The most effective way to keep Covid-19 away is regularly handwashing with soap and water.

The children are supervised washing their hands throughout the day.

Your School Nurse

Your child can have access to a School Nurse at any time if you have any health concerns, in addition your School Nurse offers a full health assessment in reception and year 6.

The School Nurse can check:


- Your child is growing healthily and support with healthy eating
- Support with access to dental care and general support for dental hygiene
- Help with day / night time wetting or soiling
- Provide information about immunisations
- Guidance re healthy lifestyles
- Support with general hygiene issues including head lice and worms
- Support with general emotional health issues
- Support to access other health professionals
- Routines, including sleep

Additionally in Year 6:

- Friendships
- Relationships
- Development, including periods and puberty
- Access to specialist services – including dietician, healthy weight programmes and voluntary services
- Developmental issues
- Transition to secondary school
- Healthy lifestyles

Spanish triathlete steps aside for British rival who made a wrong turn

A Spanish triathlete has received praise from all around the world for letting his opponent win third place in a race after he took a wrong turn. Diego Mentriga allowed Britain's James Teagle to finish ahead of him in the Santander Triathlon, after he made the wrong turn towards spectators less than 100 metres from the finish line. Teagle threw his hands in the air in agony as Mentriga overtook him. Realising his opponent's error, the 21-year-old slowed down and stopped short of the finish line. Teagle finished third by a fraction of a second.

Non Uniform Day - 50p donation to wear normal clothes - Friday 16th October

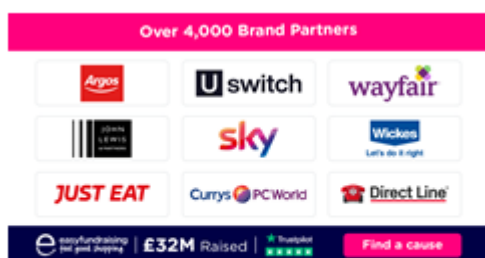
