Dear Parents,

Key Worker provision will start again on Monday 1st June and after 9 weeks at Penrice school we will return to Carclaze as we prepare for the wider reopening with the school,

Monday 1st June and Tuesday 2nd June

School is open to key workers (and vulnerable) children only. Parents of these children can access childcare through the booking form. Booking for week beginning 1st June is now closed and we have organised "bubbles" of children.

If you have children in Year 6, Year 1 or Foundation Stage they will be kept in separate bubbles ready to join their year group peers when they return.

Please only send your children in the hours you are working.

Lunch

Lunch will be eaten outside in each bubble's dedicated area or in the classroom. If you would like a school packed lunch, please remember to book on ParentPay by Sunday.

Staying safe in the sun

We want to be outside as much as we can, however staff will be unable to administer sun cream so please send your child in with 8hr sun cream applied (or their own named sun cream that they will be able to put on themselves, a hat and a bottle of water. Especially as the forecast is set for temperatures to rise next week.

Handwashing

Children will be encouraged to wash their hands on a regular basis for at least 20 seconds. Hand sanitiser will also be available.

Drop off and collection

Children have been split into bubbles with a maximum size of 15. Parents will not be allowed on site. Staff will be in the car park to assist with drop off and collection. There will be a one-way system in place on narrower paths. All key worker children will enter the school by the side nearest the bicycle shed.

Please can you let staff know what time you will collect your children.

We ask everyone to respect the 2 metre social distances.

We will be using Harlyn Bay, Sennen (both Year 4) and Pisky Cove (Year 1) classrooms. However, if your child is in Year 6, Year 1 or FS they will be in their own year group bubble.

Collection will also be from the front of the school.

Uniform

Children will need to wear school uniform from Monday
