#### Where are the test centres in Cornwall?

There are normally 4 mobile testing units that work across Cornwall, but you must book a test and not just turn up, as you may be turned away.

The website or 119 hold details of where the testing units are going to be, but these only appear a few hours before the morning and afternoon session of testing begins.

Service locations sometimes vary but are often available in the following areas, but as they rotate venues often, there will be differing availability.

- Camborne
- Falmouth
- St. Austell
- Bude
- Launceston

There are also permanent testing facility available at Plymouth and Exeter.

Please only get a test if you have symptoms.






## HALF TERM ACTIVITIES AT WHEAL MARTYN
